Hurricane Matthew – FL, NC, GA, SC, VA

Hurricane Matthew produced torrential rain and widespread flood damage in the states of Florida, North Carolina, Georgia, South Carolina, and Virginia. In NFIP Clearinghouse Bulletin W-16074, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) assigned FICO numbers 680, 681, 356, 357, 358 to track the claims arising from this event. FEMA has now adjusted the Dates of Loss for the event as shown below:
